Keeping our Campus Safe:

The Importance of your College ID

We want to keep everyone in college safe by ensuring only students, staff and authorised visitors are on campus.

You have been issued with a college Student ID card and a yellow lanyard, essential for identifying you as part of our college community. Your ID helps us ensure that only authorised individuals are on campus.

As you enter the campus boundaries, you must wear or hold your ID and yellow lanyard.

You may be subject to an ID Check of your card. Wearing your ID visibly as you enter our campuses, helps reduce the need for spot checks.

Within the campuses: You are welcome to wear your ID visibly, using your lanyard, anywhere on campus (apart from when instructed not to in some workshops for physical safety reasons).

Due to the checking regime at college gates and building entrances, you are not though required to wear your College ID visibly inside the campus boundaries and buildings.

However, at any time a member of staff asks to see your ID Card, you must politely comply.

Digital Backup

Take a clear photo of your College ID and save on your mobile.

This can be used as a backup when asked by staff or security, especially if you've temporarily misplaced your physical card.

This does not replace your physical ID - you'll still need this for access to most services.
